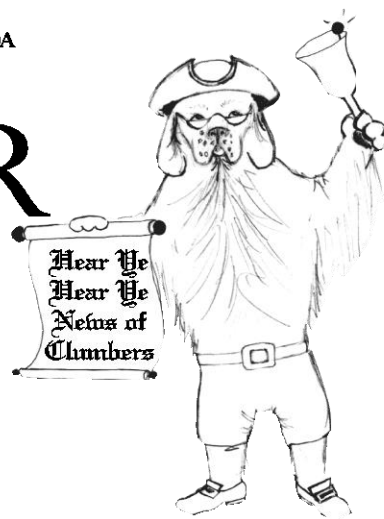

Happy Winter Everyone!

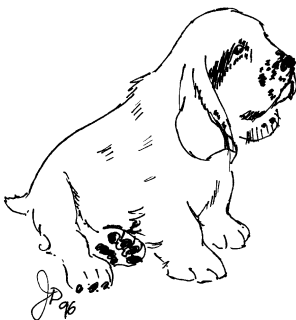
Our Clumber, loves the winter and blends in so well with a Saskatchewan field in the snow that you would think they were made for this climate!

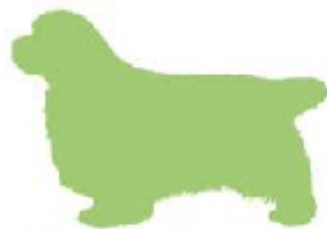

- CSHF is an independent, 501(c)(3) charitable organization, formed with a mission to promote charitable, educational and research efforts related to the Clumber Spaniel.
- During its first decade of service, 2007-2017, CSHF awarded over \$105,000 in grants.
- Grants are generally awarded in support of research that relates to an issue facing Clumber Spaniels. Some areas of research have included Hemangiosarcoma and other cancers, IVDD, and IMHA.
- Although CSHF's approach targets Clumber Spaniels, other breeds, and even mixed-breed dogs, may also benefit!
- CSHF also focuses on outreach, hosting educational events at most every National Specialty and, together with CSCA, jointly underwrote the International Symposium last year.
- CSHF manages the CSCA DNA Bank.
- CSHF encourages owners to obtain necropsies and, through the Piper Fund, provides rebates to owners who share results with the Foundation.

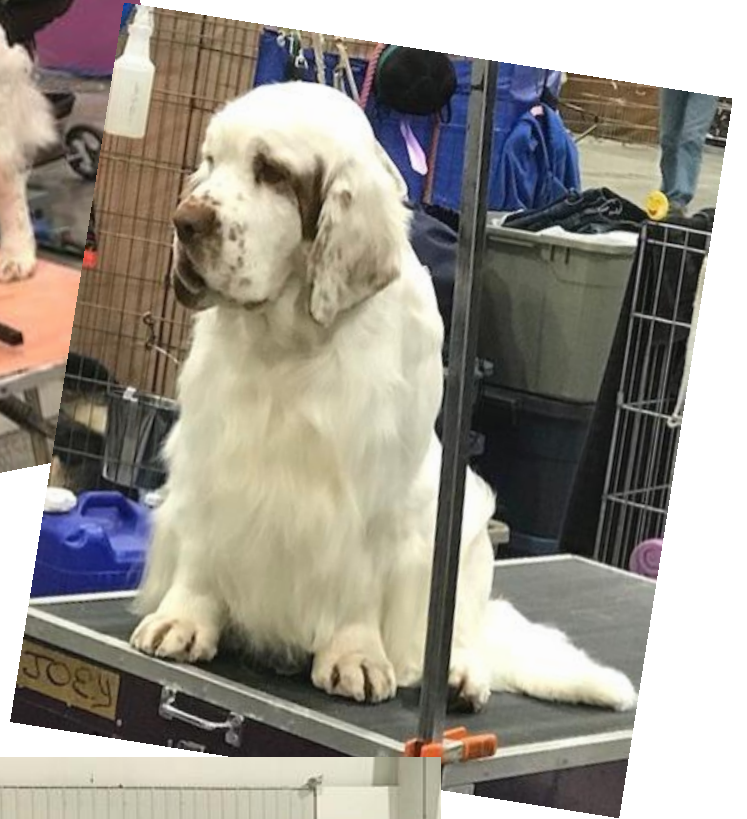
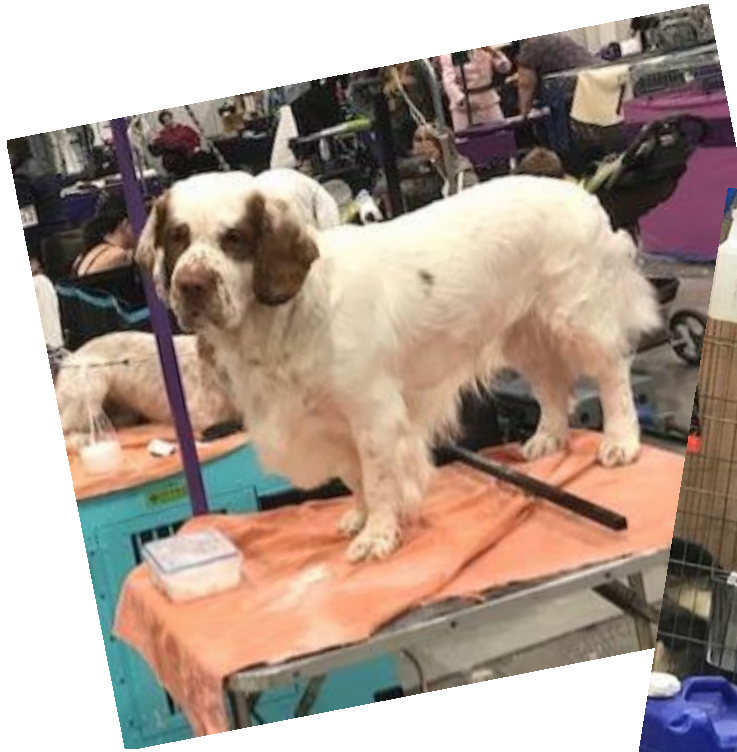

In Memory of Arthur & Copper

Fifteen years ago, I decided I wanted a Clumber Spaniel from the Clussexx Kennel. I patiently waited two years for Arthur to join our family. He came to live with me at 9 months old and was already an American Champion. Arthur was all I wanted: a handsome boy with a good temperament. He attained his Canadian Championship in one weekend as a puppy. Arthur's biggest achievement in the show ring came several years later at the 2013 CSCA National Specialty where he won Best Veteran in the Specialty Show, Regional Specialty Show and the Sweepstakes. I was so proud of him that day!

Arthur also sired a couple of litters producing some beautiful puppies, and our first Tricklecreek litters. One of his sons went on to make several records in Canada. His name was Copper, Tricklecreek Make a Memory. Copper was the #10 puppy in Canada in 2009, and went on to be a Best in Show Winner, and won 14 best Puppy in Show. He was the first male Clumber to achieve the Grand Champion Excellent title. Copper too sired a litter that produced Bacardi and JD, both multiple BIS winners. Although I am proud of what my boys accomplished for Tricklecreek in the ring and all the puppies they brought into this world, I am most proud of the fact that they retained their high spirits and good temperaments too. It's easy to see the accomplishments of our Clumbers in ribbons and prizes; but you simply can't measure the impact they have on your lives.



In Memory of Arthur & Copper Cont...

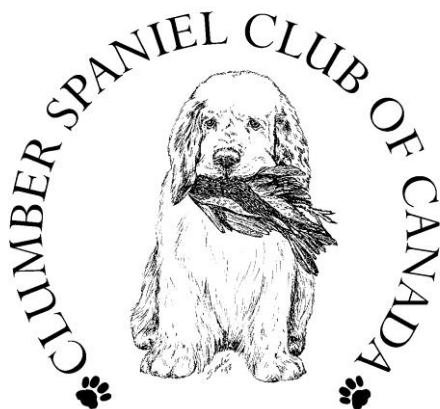
Almost a month ago, we had to send our boys over the rainbow bridge. Arthur just turned 13 years old and Copper would have been 11 this June. Losing your seniors a few weeks apart was very painful but they had giving me so much love and trust over the years I had to trust my instinct to let them go and be free. The hardest part of owning and loving an animal so much is saying goodbye. Right now, it is difficult to look at the photos and reminisce, but I know in time I will be able to look past the pain and feel the gratitude for all they brought to my life. They were my boys and their legacy will live on through their lineage here at Tricklecreek. I will miss our walks together around the acreage as that was their favorite time with me.

It's been said that we get to experience the entire lives of many of our dogs, but they are only with us for part of ours. While it may be true that Arthur and I had just 13 years and Copper almost 11, they will be a part of me always. I am so grateful for our time together.
