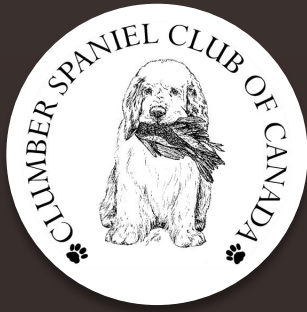

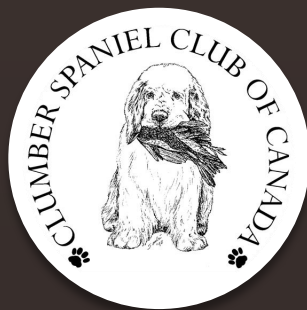

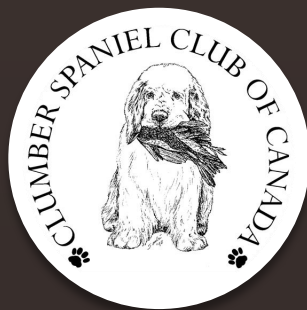

EDITORS MESSAGE

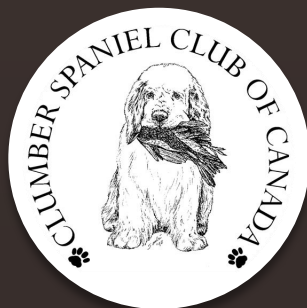
Hello Everyone,

Faith loves to work and will try most things. Our adventures began that summer when we got to know each other and she learned to swim!

We started our performance journey together in summer 2017 getting our CGN. She also got her Novice Chase Ability title and Novice Trick dog that year.

2018 was a fantastic year for Faith. She started the year with her other mother Lori-Ann in the US getting 14 pts and her majors for her American Championship. We continued working on trick titles and rally thru the winter and she breezed thru her Intermediate/Advanced trick titles and Rally Novice. At the regional specialty of the Clumber spaniel club of America in April she received select bitch. She also got one leg of her American BN, RN and her AM CGC.

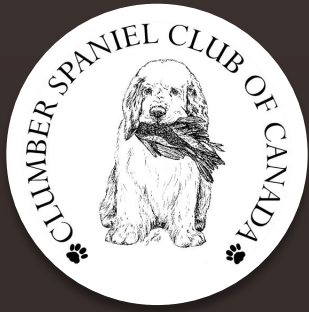
In 2018 the CKC offered Sprinter titles and Faith got her Novice Sprinter in 4 runs clocking in at ~33 km/hour. She tried Barn hunt and got her RATI (instinct level) and 2 legs towards her novice title.

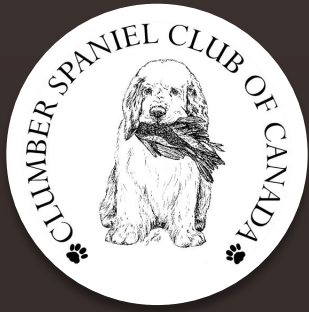

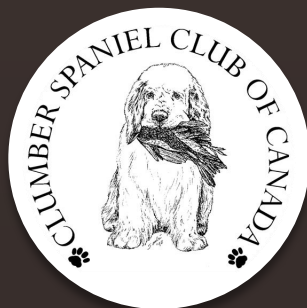
We finished off the 2018 show season getting her Rally Advanced title in three tries and ending up #1 Clumber in Canada in Rally Obedience.

Clumber Spaniel Stars in Music Video “I Got You”

Last Spring, a technology company based in the Washington, DC suburbs, shot a music video in southern California as preparation for the launch of a new high-tech product line to track and monitor animals.

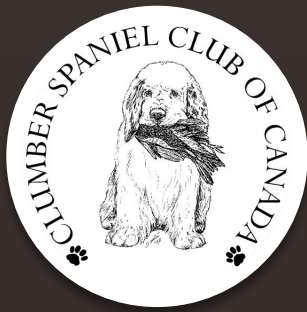
That company, Maven Tracker (by CargoSense), uses sensors to monitor the shipment of animals and temperature-sensitive cargo, utilizing its Cloud platform to send temperature and location data directly to the user. Big technology giants and pharmaceutical companies use the service, as well as veterinarians, breeders and handlers.

Theme Song

In order to express the values, the company, recruited a Brand Ambassador who was an accomplished actor, singer and songwriter. Part of her challenge was to express the value of Maven which she did by writing and recording with her partner, a theme song entitled, “I Got You”. (<https://maventracker.com/maven-pt/>)

The piece was such a catchy pop tune that a promotional music video was shot. One of the several story lines in the video was about a woman competing her dog for “Best in Show”. To make it look authentic, many award-winning show dogs and their owners were included in the shoot which took place in a park next to the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, California.

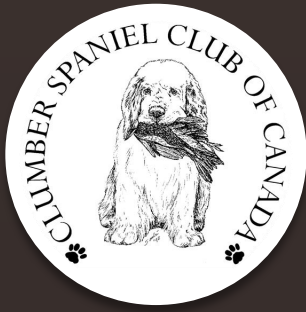

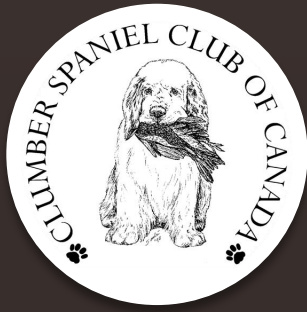
